Student Cohorts

Cohort One (A): Students Last Name A-L* attend school Monday and Thursday; remote learning takes place Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday. *Students participating in BOCES career technical education courses attend school every "A" day.*

Cohort Two (B): Students Last Name *L-Z attend school Tuesday and Friday; remote learning takes place on Monday, Wednesday and Thursday.

*This will change once we define the students that have special considerations – i.e. same household and last names split cohorts, etc.

Cohort Three: Students with special considerations and targeted academic support attend school four days with a virtual day on Wednesdays.

Virtual Cohort: Parents who chose 100% Remote Learning for their child(ren); remote learning everyday.
