Dear Frontier High School Families:

I am writing to provide you information regarding a new strategy being employed by the state in response to an increase in Covid-19 cases in WNY. Erie County has been placed in a **Yellow Zone - Precautionary/Buffer.**

Yellow Zone - Precautionary/Buffer: A "Yellow Zone" area is put in place as a broader buffer area to ensure COVID outbreak is not spreading into the broader community. If designated as a Yellow Zone, schools can potentially remain open but must begin random testing of students and staff.

As you are aware, Frontier High School went to a 2 week fully remote status beginning November 2nd. Due to a conflict in Erie1Boces schedules, we will need to modify our student bell schedule from the original letter dated 11/10/20 that was posted on the district website. Effective November 16, 2020, the following changes will take place for all students and remain in effect until further notice.

• The high school will modify our bell schedule Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday with 9 periods per day, beginning at 7:10am and ending at 1:05pm (see Bell Schedule below).

- Students will be "required" to be signed on to their classes, based on the above bell schedule as well as
 their individual class schedule which is accessible in School Tool. Students are no longer in cohorts
 during this remote learning phase. All students should attend daily. In the event we move back
 to a hybrid model, students should revert back to their original cohort. Please note that attendance will
 be taken by teachers and recorded for each period that students are required to be in a class. Students
 will also have the availability to sign into their attendance via the student portal before 9am every day.
- <u>Wednesdays will remain an asynchronous instruction day for all students</u>. Students should still check into their Google Classrooms, however they should not expect live instruction on this day.
