Chapter 12 (XII) **Q**

p128-129. Lucy asks Aslan if anything can be done to save Edmund. What does Aslan reply? How does he appear after his reply?

Chapter 14 (XIV) **Q**

p147-150. Why is Aslan sad and lonely? (Think back to the ch 12 question)? Should he feel this way? (Think ahead to ch 15)?

Ch 12

When Susan asks if anything can be done to save Edmund, Aslan replies, "All shall be done." In other words, Aslan will do everything in his power to save Edmund. Then Aslan adds, "But it may be harder than you think." **By this Aslan means that rescuing Edmund is going to be a challenge. Aslan is the king, but he is not a dictator with total power. He cannot just take Edmund away from the witch by some special magic or force. He looks sad when he says these words because he knows that saving Edmund will involve an immense personal sacrifice: pain, humiliation, and perhaps death.**

Ch 14

Aslan is sad and lonely in these pages because he has made a deal with the white witch. She has the right to kill Edmund according to the Law of deep magic because Edmund is a traitor. **No one, not even Aslan, can go against the deep magic, which was put into Narnia when the Emperor -- Aslan's own father -- created this world.**

Aslan has agreed to take Edmund's place and be put to death instead of Edmund. Aslan should feel sad and lonely **because he knows that he is going to suffer a painful and humiliating death.** [In Chapter 15, he comes back to life. Did he know with absolute certainty that he would come back from the dead?]
