 - Grades 3-5 in the morning

 - 6/16 & 6/18- Virtual student meetings with reading specialists
 - All "graduation" events are limited to 2 adults per student
 - 5th grade virtual students were invited to graduation

 - Letters were sent home to students that were invited to the "Elementary Summer Enrichment" program.
 - The program will focus on math, reading, writing and social emotional wellness.
 - Letters concerning placement for next year are due to Ms. Lester (via email is easiest) by 6/10.

- **Teacher Report (Mrs. Senese)**

 - Blasdell receives Title 1 funding based on the % of families that qualify for free/reduced lunch.
