- 6. Have constant **communication**. If at any point you feel lost and want more or a different explanation, <u>never be afraid to ask!</u>

Grading Policy Continued

- Homework will be assigned and checked daily. Homework will be done in pencil and corrections done in the correcting pen.
- Homework will be graded for effort and completeness (this means show your work and try each problem!) Homework could possibly be collected so that I can get a closer look at your work.
- Homework will be graded as follows the day it is due:

0	2	2 out of 2 (100%)	Complete with work snown
0	1	1 out of 2 (50%)	Incomplete, not all problems attempted
0	0	0 out of 2 (0%)	Work is incomplete, lacks details or unacceptable

- Late homework can receive up to a point higher (than the original grade the day of) if completed and turned in the following day.
- Daily class warm-ups will be collected and graded at the end of each week. Problems must be completed and corrected to earn credit. Each day is worth 2 points (making a week of warm-up problems worth 10 points).
- **Study guides** for quizzes are worth 4 points (double a homework assignment) and must have a minimum of 5 key topics/lessons from the unit.
- Problems of the week (**POW's**) are worth 6 points if done perfectly. If not, POW's must be corrected and handed in the next day for a one-point loss.
- On the last page, there is a homework pass that is good on any assignment
 throughout the year. You can receive another homework pass at the end of the
 quarter if all your homework is 100% completed for that quarter. If you do not wish to
 ever turn in your homework passes, at the end of each quarter, if you turn them in
 unused, points will be added to your homework grade.

Parent Portal

Grades will be posted on the parent portal (almost daily). I encourage you and your parents to check your grades often and keep track of your progress!

Absences

Each individual student is responsible for making up any missed work due to an absence. This includes completing class notes and activities, correcting prior homework, completing assigned homework, and taking tests or quizzes. You have the number of days you were absent to complete the work. For example, if you were absent for three consecutive days, you have three days to turn in the missed work.

Extra Help

Students are encouraged to seek extra help! Students may come see me during anytime I am available; Check the 'Come See Me' board in my classroom.


Note from your teacher:
