      - 1. Building Aid adjusted to reflect closed out projects
      - 2. Transportation Aid reduced on lower 2021 operating costs due to Covid19.
      - 3. Tax Levy Limit Final at 2.85%, increase of \$1,205,941.
    - ii. Miscellaneous Aids reduced on removal of Summer School tuition [\$65,000], B&A Revenue [\$412,000] and Community Ed revenue [\$158,000].
    - iii. American Rescue \$1.9 trillion is law. Potentially funds essential programming to close educational gaps for students [summer, extended school day] and address resource allocation for social/emotional needs, PPE requirements and class size management. Will play into NYS Budget and final Aid allocations due April 1. Press release indicates approximately \$4 million to FCSD, best case.
