Proposition No. 1 – 2023-24 Budget

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the budget for the Frontier Central School District (the “District”) be authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$102,237,308 for the fiscal year commencing July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024, as presented by the Board of Education, is hereby approved and adopted, and the required funds therefore are hereby appropriated, and the necessary real property taxes required shall be raised by a tax on the taxable property in the District to be levied and collected as required by law.

Proposition No. 2 - Purchase and Financing of School Buses and Similar Vehicles

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education of the Frontier Central School District (the “District”) is hereby authorized to acquire various school buses and similar vehicles for use in the transportation program of the District, at an estimated maximum cost (after the application of a trade-ins credit) of \$765,245 with such amount (plus an amount sufficient to cover interest incurred in the financing of such vehicles), to be raised by the levy of a tax upon the taxable property of the District and collected in annual installments as provided by Section 416 of the Education Law, and in anticipation of such tax, bonds, notes or other obligations of the District (including, without limitation, obligations arising under leases, lease/purchase contracts or installment purchase contracts having a term of not more than five years) shall be issued or entered into in accordance with applicable provisions of New York State law.

Proposition No. 3 - Establishment of Capital Improvements Reserve Fund

Shall the following resolution be adopted, to wit:

RESOLVED, that the Board of Education (the “Board”) of the Frontier Central School District, Erie County, New York (the “District”) is hereby authorized to establish a new capital improvements reserve fund pursuant to Section 3651 of the Education Law of the State of New York (the “Fund”); that the Fund shall be known as the “Capital Improvements Reserve Fund, 2023” of the District; that the Fund shall be established for the purpose of financing, in whole or in part, the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, expansion, renovation, alteration and improvement of buildings, facilities, sites and real property by the District, or the District’s share of the cost of any capital improvements project undertaken by a Board of Cooperative Educational Services (“BOCES”) of which the District is (or may become) a component district, including, in all cases, the acquisition of necessary furnishings, equipment, machinery and apparatus; that the ultimate amount of the Fund shall be not greater than \$5,000,000 (plus interest earned thereon); that the probable term of the Fund shall be not longer than ten (10) years; and that the permissible sources from which the Board is authorized to appropriate monies to the Fund from time to time shall be (A) budgetary appropriations of the District; (B) unappropriated fund balance of the District; (C) State aid received as reimbursement for expenditures by the District in connection with District capital improvements (whether or not such improvements were financed in whole or in part from the Fund); (D) the proceeds from the sale of unneeded real or personal property owned by the District; (E) one or more other reserve funds of the District; and/or (F) such other sources as the Board or the voters of the District may direct from time to time, all as may be permitted by law.
