Pre-K, K, Gr. 1	-Learning Packets -Online tasks / teacher assignments	-30-45 minutes per day -Include independent reading -Encourage writing through journaling -Practice grade-level math facts/skills
Gr. 2-5	-Learning Packets -Online tasks/ teacher assignments	<ul> <li>-60 minutes per day (30 minutes ELA, 30 minutes Math)</li> <li>-30 minutes per day independent reading</li> <li>-Encourage writing through journaling, poetry and writing letters/notes</li> <li>-Practice grade-level math facts/skills</li> <li>-Build in time for breaks and movement</li> </ul>
Gr. 6-8	-Learning Packets -Online tasks / teacher assignments	-20 to 25 minutes per day / per course -30 to 60 minutes per day independent reading -Encourage writing through journaling, poetry, and short stories -Build in time for breaks and movement
Gr. 9-12	-Learning Packets -Online tasks / teacher assignments	-30 minutes per day, per course -30-60 minutes per day independent reading -Encourage writing through journaling, poetry and short stories
