A friendly reminder from your local Erie County Department of Health Immunization Action Plan.

As the 2023-2024 school year comes to an end and the summer months begin, please take this time to reach out to your child's pediatrician. Schedule your child's annual routine physical and discuss any needed vaccines for the upcoming school year. Be prepared to provide the necessary school health forms and notify your school nurse regarding any chronic conditions that require additional attention. Children attending day care and Pre-K through 12th grade in New York State must receive all required doses of vaccines on the recommended schedule to attend or remain in school. If your child is specifically going into kindergarten, 6th, 7th, or 12th grade, they may require specific vaccines to attend their upcoming school year.

If you have any questions or concerns, please act early to avoid any delays with scheduling or administration. Explore health care options and ensure annual registration renewal is complete. Your primary care provider, school nurse, and the IAP program are available to answer any questions you may have. Have an enjoyable and safe summer. We look forward to a successful upcoming 2024-2025 school year.
