



Capital Project Update

On June 13, 2022, Frontier Central School District administrators and Board of Education members broke ground on the 2021 SOAR Capital Project at Frontier High School.

Last July, District voters approved the \$70.1 million project work which spans over all of our facilities and schools. Currently, the work is broken down into four phases. In addition, Phase 1 has four sub-sections, A-D. The district broke ground on Phase 1a, which represents the first wave of work being completed.

- High School: Softball and baseball turf diamonds, concession stand foundation work and piping work in the basement of the school.
- Pinehurst: Renovation of 27 classrooms, lavatory upgrades, new playground, cafeteria floor and replacement of student lockers in two wings.
- Blasdell: Two new kitchen serving lines.
- Cloverbank: Kitchen serving lines and new playground.
- Big Tree: New playground, digital entrance signs and newly designed student drop off area.
