

<p>Please provide a brief explanation of why the 2017-18 and 2018-19 school year participation rates were below 95%.</p>	<p>According to stakeholder discussion and feedback, the following factors contributed to participation rates for NYS Assessments falling well below 95%:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Length of the test, especially for the students with disabilities who sometimes work productively for four to five hours • Timely feedback and length of embargo on data • Lack of clear communication with regard to results on parent reports • Lack of parental knowledge with regard to the purpose of NYS Assessments for both parents and students • Results are often skewed as the cut scores for levels 1-4 change annually
